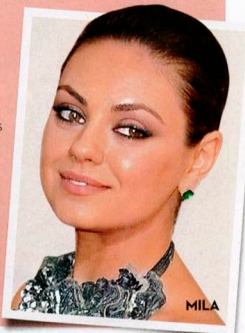
MAKEUP SHOULD BE NEUTRAL & TIMELESS
