One of the wonderful things about this brand is its stunning packaging; while we know it's what's inside that counts (and this product lives up), we can't help but love a nice wrapper; that's why some make-up stays on the counter and some lives under the sink.

This liner is several of our staffs' new favorite; it makes perfecting a cat eye a breeze. The brush tip applicator translates to smooth, precise lines; we found it was much easier to get our lines even on each side. It also dries to a satin finish which we loved since with many liquids you're left with a shinier finish.

Seas of Illumination is the highlighter we've been dream-

ing of. With a deft hand and a bit of blending, this shimmering liquid brightens your face and makes your lack of sleep and hours in front of the computer vanish. We've been trying to find more and more ways to work this gorgeous highlighter into our looks. The "Sea of Clouds" color we received is a gorgeous opalescent shade that looks like distilled moonlight. For night looks we mixed it in with a light moisturizer and used it over the arms and shoulders, it adds a subtle, goddess-like glow.
